



Right of information in relation to the data processing

Purposes	Manage the "Barcelona Black Holes (BBH) I: Primordial Black Holes" congress organised by the Institut de Ciències del Cosmos de la Universitat de Barcelona, which includes the publication of the participants list on the congress' website. If you are also a speaker, institutional promotion by taking photographs of the conference and publishing them on the ICCUB website, the UB website and in the accounts of the ICC and the conference profiles on X (before Twitter) and LinkedIn, and the ICCUB annual report. Also, the publication of your presentation, if you are a speaker and give us your consent, in the ICCUB's indico website.
Lawful basis	Regarding the management of the conference is the fulfilment of a mission carried out in the public interest (Organic Law 2/2023, of 22 March, on the University System and Law 1/2003 of 19 February, governing Catalan universities). As regards the realization of photographs, the publication of your presentation and the processing of your health data provided in the field of alimentary restrictions, it is your consent, which you can revoke at any time without having retroactive effect.
Data storage period	Data will be kept for the time necessary to fulfil the purpose for which they were collected and to determine the possible responsibilities that could be derived. Photographs will remain published for 4 years, unless you revoke your consent before that time.
Recipients	The recipient of your personal data is the University of Barcelona, and those in charge of processing your data on behalf of them, if applicable. Specifically, the company MDPI, based in Switzerland, has been hired to manage registration and payment for the conference; This company will also publish the proceedings in its Universe Journal. To execute these actions, an international data transfer will be carried out covered by the 2000/518/EC: Commission Decision of 26 July 2000 pursuant to Directive 95/46/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the adequate protection of personal data provided in Switzerland (notified under document number C(2000) 2304) . Your identifying data will be accessed by the lecturers and the other participants on the course. The list of participants and the photographs will be seen by the people who access the indicated means of diffusion
